Safety tips

Driving electric in New Zealand is one way we can help combat climate change. While it helps take care of the environment, when it comes to charging it's important you look after yourself, too.

Here's some advice on how to do just that:

- ✓ Only buy from a reputable supplier, and check that the charger is suitable for your car and charging requirements
- ✓ Ask the supplier if their chargers are compliant with WorkSafe NZ Electric Vehicle Charging Safety Guidelines
- ✓ Ask to see the Supplier Declaration of Conformity (SDoC) and the associated test certificates
- ✓ Ensure you get a certified installation by a registered electrician
- ✓ Make sure they install in accordance with WorkSafe NZ Electric Vehicle Charging Safety Guidelines and other applicable AS/NZS standards (it's a good idea to ask your electrician how they plan to meet these)
- ✓ Give your electrician the charger installation instructions
- ✓ Ask for a copy of the Certificate of Compliance your electrician will issue after installation
- ✓ Always read the charger user guides and any other safety information before use
